The pool heating was turned on fairly early this year, in late March, and will stay on until 2nd October. The filter system will remain on at a minimum level.

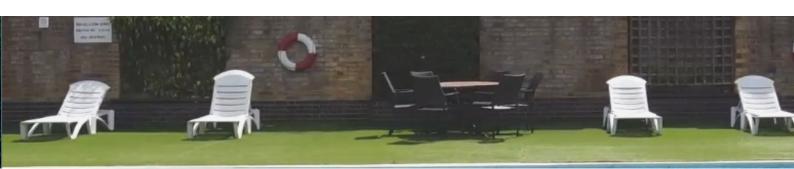

# REMINDERS

#### CHILDREN AND POOL USAGE

Please do not leave any children unattended near the pool.

As part of your agreement in the club membership, adult supervision (18 or over) should be provided to children (under 16) in your household membership in all areas of the club. Please see club rules on the website for full details.

#### **POOL COVER**

Please make sure to roll out the pool cover when you have finished using the pool (and it is obvious no one is about to start using it). This is especially important for evening swimmers.

Using the pool cover will help with the increasing fuel costs to keep the pool at a desirable temperature.

#### **LIGHTING**

If there is no one else in attendance, please turn off any lighting as you leave the club or gym.

#### **FOOTBALL**

Due to the noise and/or potential damage there is to be no football (or similar variations thereof) played in the club grounds. This includes the grass area, the tennis courts and the pool area. Please abide by this request as this forms part of your agreement to your membership terms.

# LITTER / RUBBISH

All food waste / drink cartons / packaging / waste / paper plates / etc... should be taken home with you when you leave the club (including food in fridges that will expire). There are no facilities on site to take your refuse or recycling. Adherence to this forms part of your membership terms.

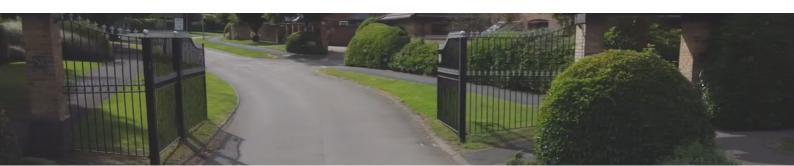

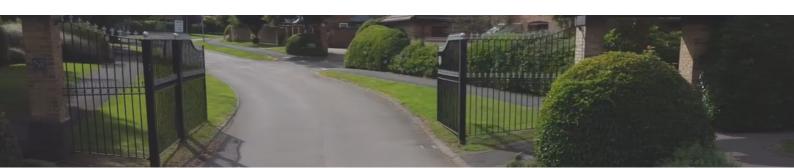
#### Breakages cost you money
