The Club will supply beef burgers, sausages and some side dishes.

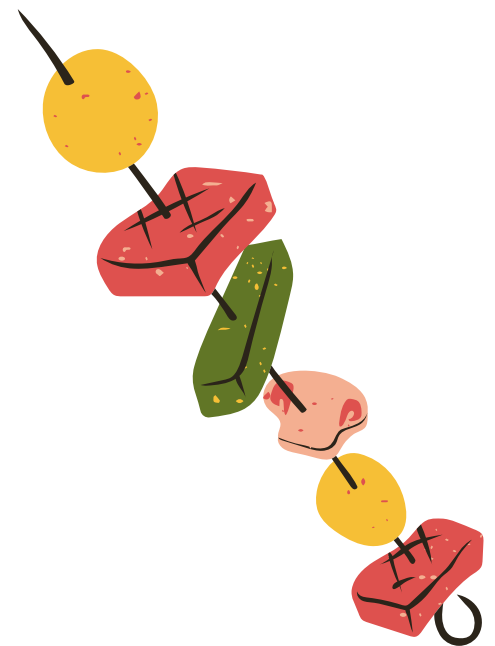
Whilst we cannot cater for every dietary requirement, we will have a range of non-meat / vegetarian options.

POOL REMINDERS

Sunday 10th October – Nick and Harrison will shut down the pool heating system. (The filter system will remain on at a minimum level.)

Whilst we use the term "pool closure" for this, only the heating system for the pool will be switched off.

Those that enjoy a colder swim can continue to do so.

Please note, at water temperatures below 15 degrees celsius, the advice provided by www.swimserpentine.co.uk would be to use a wet-suit for any distance.

The club does not provide a pool life-guard / attendant. User discretion is advised.

The pool heating system will be switched on again in May 2022 (or sooner).
